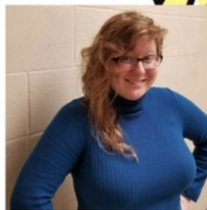

ED TECH SPOTLIGHT

Paige Colwell

Ms. Colwell teaches Introduction to Art, Animation, Drawing, and Painting to 6th, 7th and, 8th graders at Mckinley Middle Magnet.



What drives you to integrate technology into your teaching? *

We live in an increasingly tech dependent world. The ability to work with technology is an integral 21st century skill that students need to know in order to thrive when they leave the school building.

How does technology enhance student learning? *

Technology is used several ways in my classroom. For a lot of my students it is incredibly beneficial to not only have a demo done in person, but to also have written, picture and video instructions available to them in case they forget something or need to refresh. Some students find their talents lie in digital art more so than traditional art. If that is the case technology allows me to differentiate my lessons to accommodate students who all need to work at different levels.

List your top three tech tools you recommend other teachers to try. *

1. Minecraft for Education - it is SO COOL and SO much fun. It is applicable to every subject area.
2. Google Forms, but specifically how to create a choose your own adventure game out of them.
3. Google Slides, I'm sure many teachers already use Google Slides, but there are SO many more things that can be done with it that I don't think teachers know how to do. Choose your own adventure games, choice boards, digital planners, the list goes on.

What advice would you give other teachers about integrating technology in their classroom? *

Take it slow with your kids for a minute. Remember to plan to teach them how to use and navigate, don't just assume they know how. Many of them are technology wiz kids, and those students can help you teach the others.

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Bike Lane Boost

A year after the arrival of bike lanes, Madison Avenue sees property investments

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A year ago, city roads crews were wrapping up the installation of dedicated bike lanes on the two-mile stretch of Madison Avenue between McNeil and Cooper streets – the culmination of an extensive debate that included those radically for or radically against the two-wheeled route that entailed a major road diet and on-street parking.

Today, several properties along the corridor have seen drastic improvements, a handful of new businesses have opened and quite a few more are under construction. And whether that's a direct result of the bike lanes or not, it speaks volumes to the resurgence of the neighborhood
